The approval of the minutes for the meeting of April 7th was continued to the next meeting.

Dr. Larson summarized his discussion with Paul Hubbman. Dr. Larson indicated that Mr. Hubbman was willing to speak at the upcoming Chamber general membership meeting (GMM) and that Mr. Hubbman may also be available to meet with the group on a quarterly basis if needed.

The group discussed the upcoming GMM. It was decided that each of the cities and MoDOT, would bring the enhancement project boards to the meeting.
