The County Older Resident Programs (CORP) supports Saint Louis County older adults through a full range of program activities that are designed to enhance their lives. **Program services are available to Saint Louis County Residents age 60 and older.** Many of CORP's services are provided by trained volunteers.

Socialization Services

Visit with a neighbor or meet new people while participating in fun social activities.

Clubs and Special Interest Groups

CORP offers opportunities for sharing hobbies, talents, or turn any day into a special occasion doing the things you enjoy.

Socialization Activities

Participate in monthly social events and enjoy fun activities such as flower arranging or a behind the scenes tour of the Fox Theatre.

Lifelong Learning

Become more familiar with technology basics and helpful community resources on aging successfully.

This program is available to adults age 50 and older.

Age Smart. Age Well.

CORP focuses on promoting activities which showcase active aging. For example, Broadway Fantasies, an annual song and dance revue, highlights the musical talents of older adults. In addition, you can learn tips on adapting to life's changes through gerontology training; you can take advantage of community resources, free computer and technology classes and even get involved with a volunteer assignment!



Neighbor Helping Neighbor

Whether it is a visit to the doctor, fixing a leaky pipe, or simply a kind voice, CORP is here to help.

Neighbor Driving Neighbor

Get where you need to be, when you need to be there. Volunteers provide transportation to and from doctor's appointments and to other essential destinations.

Care Calls & Home Visits

Volunteers offer telephone reassurance and friendly conversation. Spend time with a CORP Volunteer chatting, playing a game, or doing your favorite activity in your home. Volunteers can also check on your wellbeing.

Case Management

Do you have concerns about living conditions, personal or health needs? Case Managers help assess situations that may make it difficult to continue independent living. After a home visit and an assessment, the Case Manager creates an individualized care plan and offers resources to keep you healthy and safe.

Home Care and Repair

Get the home repairs you need while feeling secure in your home or apartment. We can connect you to workers for your minor home repairs and in-home services. Customers are responsible for payment of labor, materials, and other related costs.

Caregiver to Caregiver

Respite Volunteers are there to sit with your loved one when you need to run errands or take some time for yourself.

Professional Services

A resource for tax assistance and non-litigation legal assistance. Services are available for individuals at or below a certain income level and age.

Tax Services

CORP Volunteers assist with simple State and Federal tax forms, as well as the Missouri Property Tax Credit (Circuit Breaker).

Legal Assistance

Volunteer Attorneys provide specific legal services such as: preparation of simple wills, quit claim deeds, powers of attorney, and other documents.

Access & Functional Needs Registry

The Registry is an emergency preparedness program developed in collaboration with Saint Louis County's Office of Emergency Management and administered by the Department of Human Services. Elderly and disabled St. Louis County Residents tell first emergency responders that they need more or special help during a disaster or crisis. The Registry is used for planning purposes and in actual events, to coordinate and prioritize emergency response.
