2022 Christmas Tree Collection

Brush Chipping Program

Brush and tree trimming collections occur each spring and fall. Brush and tree trimmings are to be placed by the road no later than the Sunday night prior to your district's scheduled week for pickup. The Public Works crew will spend one week in the spring and two weeks in the fall in each district. Due to time constraints, they will not be able to return to a street after the brush pickup is completed. During the collection period you may call the public works department at (636) 591-6666 for daily recorded updates. Limbs should be cut in 4 to 12-foot lengths and must not be thicker than 4 inches in diameter. The following are some of the items that will not be chipped or picked up: trash, bushes with stumps, honeysuckle, bamboo, thorny material, leaves, grass, wood with nails or wire attached, trees with stumps, lumber, construction debris, dirt or rocks. These items could damage the processing equipment or injure an employee.

Leaf Collection Program

Public Works will begin the 2021 Fall Leaf Collection in early November. Each district will receive two passes with specific dates for leaf collection. Leaf collection will begin in District 1 on November 1 followed by District 2 starting on November 11 and then District 3 beginning on November 18. Once complete a second pass will be made starting in District 1 on December 2 followed by District 2 on December 21 and finishing in District 3 beginning December 29. During the collection period you may call the public works department at (636) 591-6666 for daily recorded updates. Residents who wish to clear leaves off of their property for collection may rake the leaves in rows to the edge of the street gutter or ditch line. Please keep leaves off the street and do not block storm water inlets. Remove rocks, glass, branches or other hard materials from piles left for collection. Such items are harmful to city equipment and may injure an employee during collection of leaves. Unfortunately, we cannot specify the exact time or date collection on a particular street will occur. You may have your leaves out at any time during the collection season, however, please keep in mind the collection dates for your area. If you want your leaves removed by a certain date or you miss the collection times in your area you do have a couple of options. You may bag them, attach a yard waste tag, and have our refuse hauler pick them up on the same day trash and recycling are collected. Please note our refuse hauler does not collect yard waste during the winter months of January and February. You may also drop leaves off during the leaf collection program only, November 1, 2021 through January 14, 2022, at the city mulching facility located at 553 Old State Road. Leaves should be loose when dropped off, no bags please. The mulching facility is open daily from sunrise to sunset.
