Bluebird Park Amphitheater Guidelines

- The amphitheater may be reserved from April through October until 9:00 p.m. Monday –Thursday, until 10:00 p.m. on Friday and Saturdays and until 9:00 p.m. on Sundays.
- The amphitheater may be reserved until dusk from November through March.
- Some dates and times may not be available due to events already scheduled in the park and at the amphitheater.
- Application for use of the Bluebird Park Amphitheater should be submitted at least five business days in advance of the requested date.
- Ellisville Police may be required for events at the amphitheater. This will be determined by the City of Ellisville based on the usage of the amphitheater.
- The person that reserves the amphitheater is responsible for the clean-up of the facility and amphitheater grounds immediately following the event. Trash receptacles will be provided.
- In accordance with the Ellisville City Code, no solicitation or sales of any kind may be conducted in Bluebird Park and no public events where admission is charged.
- No glass containers are allowed in Bluebird Park. No parking is allowed on any grass area in Bluebird Park. Parking is allowed on parking lots only.
- A sound system is not provided. Several 110V electric outlets are available for use. 220V is available upon request.
- A maximum of five vehicles are allowed to be parked at the amphitheater stage during the reservation.
- The amphitheater reservation form should be submitted to the Ellisville Parks and Recreation Department and a date selected based on available dates in Bluebird Park.
- **For the summer of 2021**, St. Louis County Health Department COVID-19 guidelines should be followed. The parks and recreation staff will provide information to you to meet these guidelines based on your expected attendance.
